• <u>Aim</u>

Training in Mission: For young people to experience God's grace and love, to learn and live out their faith, and to challenge them to devote themselves to God through the participation in mission; and further, be willing to be involved in ecumenical movement and construct a life of identification, devotion and growth.

Objectives

- 1. To widen overseas youth's knowledge and understanding about people and the church in Taiwan through mission involvement (e.g. teaching English in summer camp) in a cross cultural and multi-religious context alongside Taiwan's young people.
- 2. Develop a network among overseas youth, Taiwanese youth and churches.
- 3. Leadership training and nurturing through participation in community mission and evangelism.
- 4. Motivate ecumenical involvement in local churches.
